Further Afield

a number of value hotels and motels are available in surrounding towns and suburbs. Many suburbs are poorly connected to Boston (e.g., Danvers, Woburn), however, a few are well connected by rail, T, or inexpensive UBER rides.

Waltham

Home of Brandeis University and Boston's Tech Circle

Prices for weekend stays are quite reasonable
even adding \$20 each way for UBER or 1 hr by bus

Braintree

South of Boston

Most hotels are a 2 mile cab/UBER ride from
the Quincy Adams T Red stop, named for Boston's
least heralded president
